

 Railways and The Met Office to learn about the apprenticeship opportunities available with
 these organisations. They were able to drive a train using the train simulator and had a talk from
 a Chief Forecaster to understand how weather predictions are made. These were very
 interesting visits showing students what job opportunities there are and the progression
 available.
- Our Year 9 football team have clinched their spot in the prestigious Devon Cup Final. The team showcased talented performances and sportsmanship throughout the competition. They have overcome some outstanding school teams to reach the final and displayed incredible levels of determination.
