- Exam board: Edexcel
- Title: GCSE 9-1
- Content:
 - Medicine in Britain (c.1250-present)
 - Early Elizabethan England
 - Weimar & Nazi Germany, 1918-1939
 - The American West (c.1835-1895)

When are the exams and how long are they? What is in the exams?

- All exams take place in the summer of Year 11. There are 3 papers
 1. Medicine in Britain (1hr 15mins = 30%)
 2. American West & Elizabethan England (1hr 45mins = 40%)
 3. Germany (1hr 20mins = 30%)
