When are the exams and how long are they?

- All in the summer of Year 11.
- 6 x 1 hour and 10 minute exams
 - (2 x Biology, 2 x Chemistry, 2 x Physics)

What is in the exams?

- Each exam has a specific content section which questions can be related to. These are clearly marked within the textbook available via Active Learn.
