

**Year 7 Catch up Funding:**

All students eligible for catch up funding have increased English and Maths	To provide students with below standard at KS2 in Maths with additional time to improve numeracy skills	All students eligible for catch up funding have one hour of Maths every day	All catch up students have 1 hour of individualised work specific to their weaknesses in Maths. Over 2017-2018 students made between 0.2 and 0.5 grades progress over the year.
All students eligible for catch up funding have one hour of individualised homework using Sparx	Homework focuses on students weaknesses over time. It works on interleaving and reviewing content. It encourages students to develop metacognitive strategies with short videos to guide them	Students are expected to complete 1 hour of compulsory homework weekly. They are then set an option and a target homework, the latter focusing on their weaknesses. Students are given weekly lesson time to focus on their target homework with the support of the classroom teacher	Over 2017-2018 students made between 0.2 and 0.5 grades progress over the year. Numeracy skills have improved and students are more confident in recalling knowledge
Students with extremely low KS2 scores targeted for "success at arithmetic" program	A short intensive course to boost numeracy skills	Students have two sessions a week for 6 weeks focusing on core numeracy skills	Increased confidence in 4 operations. Over 2017-2018 students made between 0.2 and 0.5 grades progress over the year.
